Enrollment

Total currently enrolled for year 2022/2023 is 338 scholars. Classes are starting on time and running smoothly. Enrollment entered in GaDoe system. Missed the SCSC 2% projection requirement by 1 scholar.

Annual Audit Report (DE 46)

This year's financial audit has been submitted on time

The entire financial report was registered with the SCSC as required by Georgia statutes.

United States Department of Civil Rights

The office of Civil Rights (OCR) has received a copy of the Georgia Department of Education investigation and their findings. We were instructed to go on hold while they review the report. The OCR has no intention of investigating a complaint which has already been resolved by another state agency. We received a confirming letter this week. No investigation will take place.

Special Ed. MOE Report

All Special Ed. Reports are now filed for 2021 2022 school year.

Staff Status

We started the school year with a licensed teacher in every classroom. We have made offers to (2) paraprofessionals for classroom support in grades K – 5th as Ms. Moss will be leaving in January 2023 and the 4th grade Paraprofessional resigned.

Sports Status

Basket Ball has started its season with a boys and girls game at Flint River Academy. The Boys Team won their first Game and the girls lost in a close battle. The second and third Games were canceled due to student illness and a gas leak at one school. There are 21 games on this year's schedule. Boys (A and B teams) and girls play at the same location on the same days. I will send out an update next week.

Concussion Protocol and Sudden Cardiac Arrest

Athletic Director Hill shared with me a document used at the opening of each sport that reviews both Concussion Protocol and Sudden Cardiac. This will complete our requirement during our annual monitoring by the SCSC.

Charter Obligations

During the monthly meeting of the State Charter School Commission (SCSC) the state charter schools were listed on a performance matrix. Our current numbers are within acceptable ranges in our financial measurements:

Current assets divided by current liabilities	Exceeds Standard – 10.88 (1.0 to 3.0 Meets)
Unrestricted Cash	Exceeds Standard – 338.69 (Greater than 75)
Efficiency Margin	Exceeds Standard - 192% (10% or Greater)

QBE Funding for 2022

November QBE allotment was = \$330,447.00. We should expect this to remain consistent. We will be watching to see how this effects our monthly income in December.

Mr. Kee and Mr. Hooper presented the idea of a charter school in the city of warm springs. City council was acceptable and we returned to look at the existing facility. Discussions are ongoing.

School Drills

The first security drills were reported for August, September and October:

Weather Drill -	Nov. 8 th (Hurrian Activity)
System Test -	Dec. 16 th

New Fire drill process tested and appears to be working. Scholars go on hold during a fire drill. The office releases the scholars and staff when it is safe to egress.

Professional Development

We are looking at January 2 (a teacher work day) to execute a “Gun shot on campus” demonstration for the staff. Letters will be issued to the property owners association, 911 office, and surrounding business. The exercise will consist of fire arm simulation in a sequence of:

1 single shot, 1 1 double shots, 1 1 1 three shots in suggestion. Each exercise will be done in five areas about the building so the staff can hear:

1. A close shot to their room
2. A shot from several halls away
3. A shot from the opposite side of the building

This exposure to the sound of gunfire was suggested by both the FBI and Department of Homeland Security in multiple presentations. Letters have gone out to: Property Association, 911 office, Major Crook and surrounding businesses. Those who wish to “Opt-Out” have been given the opportunity. We will debrief as a staff at 10:00 following the exercise.

State Health Insurance Program

We have received notice that we are accepted in the State Health Benefit Plan (SHBP) Blue Cross Health Program with enrollment dates of Dec 1st through the January 1st 2023. This is the same program public schools and state employees are on. This health program remains available to teachers who retire in the state of Georgia. The difference in cost for an employee with family coverage is:
