February 2024

Enrollment

Total current enrolled for year 2023/2024 is 351 scholars. In the previous year we had 339 students at this time. Full Time Enrollment (FTE) counts are entered with the state in October and March. QBE adjustments are made based on these two enrollment figures. It is not unusual for young families to move in/on/or around January 1st of each year. Job changes, military assignments, Air-Line adjustments and seasonal layoffs all effect this change. Every elementary school in the country typically experiences this phenomenon.

Charter Obligations

During the monthly meeting of the State Charter School Commission (SCSC) the state charter schools were listed on a performance matrix. Our current numbers are within acceptable ranges in our financial measurements:

Current assets divided by current liabilities	Exceeds Standard – 27.10 (1.0 to 3.0 Meets)
Unrestricted Cash	Exceeds Standard – 398 (Greater than 75)
Efficiency Margin	Exceeds Standard – 186% (10% or Greater)
Debt to Asset ratio	Exceeds Standard - 11% (Below 25%)

Flu Season

Code Yellow on Campus

On Friday February 2nd the school went into a code yellow lockdown. No scholars were allowed to leave the building. No visitors were allowed past the front entrance. Camera were shifted to cover all entrances and close proximity. Cameras were monitored full time. Outside doors were checked and confirmed to be locked. Movement inside the building continued as normal. A local police action setoff this alarm.

March Madness

Tutoring sessions on Saturdays begin in March. The first three Saturdays we begin tutoring at 9:00am and conclude at 12:00. This is a highly attended vent and we typically have over 100 students on campus all three days. All grade levels have the opportunity to attend tutoring sessions.

Fentanyl - Test Kit

Alcohol – Test Kit

Opioid Overdose - Naloxone

Charter Renewal

Our current charter expires on June 30th 2025. We will need to file an application by Nov. 1st 2024 for a renewal review. Comprehensive Performance Frameworks currently indicates a recommendation of 5 year renewal. We will confirm this position with the SCSC prior to the application.
