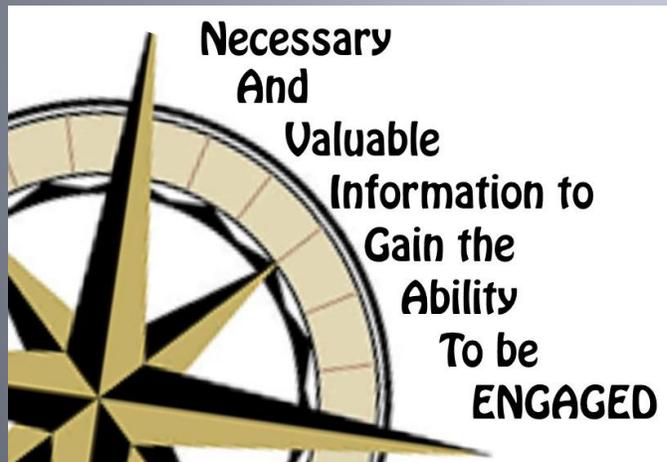


Let's Navigate Flocabulary
