Enrollment

Total current enrolled for year 2023/2024 is 344 scholars. In the previous year we had 329 students at this time. Full Time Enrollment (FTE) counts are entered with the state in October and March. QBE adjustments are made based on these two enrollment figures. (\$430,529.00)

Charter Obligations

During the monthly meeting of the State Charter School Commission (SCSC) the state charter schools were listed on a performance matrix. Our current numbers are within acceptable ranges in our financial measurements:

Governors Package Not Yet Signed

Governor Kemp has a bill on his desk which would raise the base pay for teachers \$2,500.00 There is also raise for full time Nurses to \$55,000.00 from the current \$42,000.00 full time.

Charter Renewal

Our current charter expires on June 30th 2025. We will need to file an application by Nov. 1st 2024 for a renewal review. Comprehensive Performance Frameworks currently indicates a recommendation of 5 year renewal. We will confirm this position with the SCSC prior to the application.

Parent Teacher Conferences (Student Led Conference)

The Coweta County school district reports a 12 to 14 % parent participation in parent conferences. This year Odyssey had 98% parent attendance. (With the following anomalies)
