
### Principal Report

## **Enrollment and Attendance (see attached data sheet)**

Chronically absent is 10% of the school year or 18 days. Violators are to be turned over to the juvenile judge in Coweta county courts.



Our current attendance year-to-date is 98% with a daily average of 3.5 scholars absent.

# Lowest Performing Schools in Georgia (see attached list) Note: Current List

The Governor's office on Education produced a list of the lowest performing schools in the state. The lowest 25% is called out in a house bill on school choice. The list determines which students are eligible for the <u>Promise Schools</u> voucher program, which will give up to \$6,500 to families to pay for private school tuition or home-school expenses. Gov. Brian Kemp signed the voucher bill into law earlier this year. We have received several calls regarding students who wish to transfer.

# **Random Search (Status)**

# Currently on Hold:

Legal Advisory: Currently the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) is reviewing several schools with similar policies. No legal tests have run in Georgia. "Question- Does the current state of violence in public schools raise the level of concern to a search without cause status? Litigation may soon follow. Metal detectors have stood and passed this question. Random searches have not.

Update: Coweta County schools did a random check of several schools in their system. Lockers, classrooms, backpacks and students were searched. This was the result of numerous (3 of record) drug overdose situations during the month of November.

Several schools throughout the country are currently in legal actions with parents over random searches. More specific results and legal opinions should be coming out soon.

## **Charter Renewal**

The CCRPI data for the 2024 charter renewal has partially arrived. Operations and Finance are logged. Academics should be available no later than December 28<sup>th</sup>. The deadline for the application for renewal has been moved back to January 8<sup>th</sup> 2025. We have completed the application with the exception of the academic data. When the data arrives we will submit the application.
