Does every class have a paraprofessional?

Yes! At Odyssey, we have paraprofessionals in every classroom from kindergarten through fifth grade.



How many students are in a class?

**Kindergarten through 3rd grade
22 students per class**

**Which is a 1:1
student to teacher ratio!!**

4th - 8th grade
25 students per class



What sight word list should we learn?

That depends on the school you will attend in the fall. Whichever list you use, start with the pre-primer list. If your child masters this list, then you can move on to the primer list.

Do kindergarteners get computers?

All students kindergarten through eighth grade have an assigned Chromebook which makes us a 1:1 technology school.

Kindergarten and first grade chromebooks are touch screen capable.
