Monitoring 2024 2025

A corrective action plan (CAP) was submitted prior to Feb. 19th. This year the Operational Monitoring only listed one (1) Finding with the Parent Bill of Rights policy which was updated last month. The Financial Monitoring reflected 4 findings which have been submitted as a corrective action plan.

Open House

Kindergarten Open House was January 28th from 6:00pm to 8:00pm. Kindergarten Teachers and Paras toured 15 sets of new families. All 15 families enrolled that evening. A school wide Open House will be on February 25th. All grades will be available for enrollment. Lottery for those grades with a waiting list will be on March 4th at 6:00pm. Lottery will be live at the school and results posted next day on the school website. Parents who were successful in the lottery will be contacted by the registrar within 24 hours.

Flue and Attendance

Numberous school districts in the area are experiencing high rates of illness due to the flue conditions. 10 states have had entire districts closed due to high rates of absenteeism. Polk County (all schools), west of Cobb County, closed for 3 days to sanitize. We are watching these numbers closely. Part of the reason for the winter break being in the middle of February is to break up the influenza which occurs each year.

Teachers are sanitizing their rooms at the end of each school day. Hand sanitizer is in every room and scholars are required to utilize hand sanitizing whenever they leave the room and when they re-enter the room.

Parent Teacher Conferences

In most public schools the parent teacher conferences are not typically well attended. Most schools will boast of a 20% attendance by the families. The families who you really need to talk too usually do not show up. Odyssey has had 95% or better attendance by parents for the last 8 years. Most teachers will get 100% with some parents coming in during the school day to make up the meeting if they cannot attend. The record so far belongs to third grade, Ms. Barsky's class.
