## **Monitoring 2024 2025**

Results of the 2024 2025 monitoring have arrived. A corrective action plan (CAP) will be submitted prior to Feb. 19<sup>th</sup>. The CAP will be shared with the board prior to submission. This year the Operational Monitoring only listed a Finding with the Parent Bill of Rights policy. The Financial Monitoring reflected 4 findings which are now being studied and reviewed.

## **Intruder Training**

During the professional development day on January 3<sup>rd</sup>, a shooting exercise was executed on campus. Shots were fired on a schedule and at 6 locations around the building. Teachers were in their classroom as if it were a normal school day. Six (6) shots were fired at each location 2 minutes apart. This allows staff to hear shots far away, down the hall and right outside of their door. The blanks utilized are the same as used in movies, so the sound and smell is very real.

In numerous FBI reports following school shootings teachers were quoted as saying “I heard something, I did not know what it was, so I went to investigate”.

Our staff is trained to keep the door locked at all times during the day.

Call the office if they hear a noise that concerns them.

Now that they have heard shots fired in their school, they are much better prepared to deal with the issue should it ever arise.
