Parents Complaint to the Georgia Department of Education

We were informed that the ongoing investigation by the Floyd family had reached a conclusion. The Georgia Department of Education, Special Investigator Case Number 23-339752 is resolved as follows:

United States Department of Civil Rights

We received notice Wednesday that an OCR Complaint was filed against the school stating: "Scholar was denied admission on the basis of their disability".

Research reveals that the scholar was enrolled but failed to show up for school for the first 10 days of the school year. This requires us to drop the scholar from enrollment.

Legal is gathering the data requested by the OCR and will respond appropriately.

This is the same family investigated by the GaDoe Special Education Departments and found to be unsubstantiated.

Staff Status

Mrs. Shelbra Mayes Death. – On the evening of Tuesday Nov.15th Mrs. Mayes passed away at home with her family present. This was sudden and unexpected. School schedules were altered and additional guidance counselors were on hand to support students and staff through this most difficult time.

We started the school year with a licensed teacher in every classroom. We have made offers to (2) paraprofessionals for classroom support in grades K – 5th as Ms. Moss will be leaving in January 2023 and the 4th grade Paraprofessional resigned.

Sports Status

Basket Ball has started its season with a boys and girls game at Flint River Academy. The Boys Team won their first Game and the girls lost in a close battle. The second and third Games were canceled due to student illness and a gas leak at one school. There are 21 games on this year's schedule. Boys (A and B teams) and girls play at the same location on the same days.

School Drills

The first security drills were reported for August, September and October:

Lock Down Drill -	August 26 th
Fire Drill -	September 14 th
Weather Drill -	September 29 th
Fire Drill -	Oct 3 rd (Construction Dust)
Weather Drill -	Nov. 8 th (Hurrian Activity)

New Fire drill process tested and appears to be working. Scholars go on hold during a fire drill. The office releases the scholars and staff when it is safe to egress.

Professional Development

We are looking at January 2 (a teacher work day) to execute a “Gun shot on campus” demonstration for the staff. Letters will be issued to the property owners association, 911 office, and surrounding business. The exercise will consist of starter pistol blanks being fired from a starter pistol in a sequence of: 1 single shot, 1 1 double shots, 1 1 1 three shots in suggestion. Each exercise will be done in three areas about the building so the staff can hear:

1. A close shot to their room
2. A shot from several halls away
3. A shot from the opposite side of the building
4. Shots fired outside of the building

This exposure to the sound of gunfire was suggested by both the FBI and Department of Homeland Security in multiple presentations.
